What happens in the Big Story of the Bible?

The Bible is a big story about God and his friendship with humans.

What happened on Palm Sunday?

On Palm Sunday, Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey and everyone cheered and celebrated

What happened on Maundy Thursday?

On Maundy Thursday, Jesus washed his disciples' feet and then he shared a meal of bread and wine with them. The bread was to remind them of his body and the wine was to remind them of his blood.

What happened on Good Friday?

On Good Friday, Jesus was put on a cross to die. Christians believe he did this to save people from their sins.

What happened on Easter Sunday?

On Easter Sunday, Christians believe that Jesus came back to life and appeared to his friends.

Palm Sunday





His friend Judas betrayed Jesus and told the Jewish leaders where he was.


Then Jesus went to pray in a garden and Judas brought soldiers to have him arrested
