- To make sure the school is a safe and secure place for everyone.


The Headteacher, Governors and staff will work together:

What is Bullying?

A bully is someone who hurts someone else by using behaviour which is meant to hurt, frighten or upset another person. This behaviour is repeated frequently.

Bullying Can be.....





If you are bullied:

Do:

- Ask them to STOP Stand up against
- Walk away.
- Tell someone



Don't:

- Think it's your fault.
- Do what they say.
- Get angry or hit them
- Keep it inside.

If it happens again, or you are too scared to speak openly about it,

- TELL SOMEONE;
- Talk to a friend.

What should I do, if I see someone else is being bullied?

- Tell an adult straight away.
- Don't try and get involved, you might end up getting hurt, or you could end up in trouble yourself.
- Don't stay silent, or the bullying will keep happening

What will happen to a bully?

Teachers will get involved and help everyone solve the problems. They can talk to you, your parents and talk to your friends.
